

RISK ANALYSIS CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

The answer 'low' means that your organisation is aware of these risks and mitigating them. 'Medium' means that your organisation is aware of the risks, but not always mitigating them properly and 'high' means that your organisation isn't aware of these risks and is not mitigating any of them. Any area you have answered with 'low' needs to be included in your Child Protection Policy.
